SERVICE EXCELLENCE SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

SCHOLARSHIP OVERVIEW

The First Bank & Trust Co. ("FBTC") Service Excellence Scholarship (the "Scholarship") aims to support high school seniors who have demonstrated a commitment to academic achievement and community service. By applying for or accepting the Scholarship, applicants agree to the following terms and conditions.

ELIGIBILITY

- The Scholarship offer is limited to high school seniors who, as of the entry date, are:
 - accepted or enrolled as an undergraduate student at an accredited post-secondary institution in Fall 2026
 - a resident within thirty (30) miles of an FBTC banking center
 - have a minimum GPA of 2.75
- FBTC has the right to verify the eligibility of each applicant and, in its sole discretion, disqualify any individual from participating in the Scholarship.

APPLICATION PERIOD

- The application acceptance period begins at 12:00 AM CST on April 6, 2026 and ends at 11:59 PM CST on April 30, 2026.
- All applications must be received on or before the deadline above.

HOW TO APPLY

- To apply for the Scholarship, visit <https://www.fb247.com/service-excellence-scholarship> ("Website") and following the directions to complete the on-screen application form in its entirety by the deadline specified above.
- Only applications received during the period stated above will be eligible for the Scholarship.
- Applicants that do not meet the minimum requirements set forth in these guidelines will be disqualified.
- Only one application per student. Applicants who attempt to submit additional applications by using multiple email accounts, identities, registrations, or any other methods may be disqualified.

RECIPIENT SELECTION

- All eligible applications received during the Application Period will be reviewed by the FBTC Scholarship Committee.
- Announcements and instructions for scholarship collection will be sent to the applicant's high school.

This scholarship will be awarded to, at maximum, five high school seniors per school year. It will be paid directly to the post-secondary school during the recipient's first semester in the amount of \$1,000.00. No scholarship award(s) will be paid directly to the recipient.

RELEASE

To receive the scholarship, recipient(s) must provide an official copy of their enrollment in the post-secondary institution, including contact information for the University/College Bursar Office, via mail or e-mail no later than December 1, 2026.
